Fremont Street Experience – *Downtown Las Vegas*

There is always something going on at the Fremont Street Experience located in the heart of downtown Las Vegas on the historic street that started it all. The world-famous, one-of-a-kind entertainment venue is home to Viva Vision, the biggest big screen on the planet. More than 12 million lights in the Viva Vision canopy and 550,000 watts of concert quality sound pumped to speakers throughout the venue produce an incredible array of eye-popping imagery and heart pounding music. Viva Vision shows appear nightly on the hour beginning at dusk and are free and open to the public. The giant LED screen towers 90-feet above a pedestrian mall lined with unique retail shopping kiosks and two permanent performance stages. Ten legendary casinos line Fremont Street Experience with more than 60 restaurants. Free concerts, special events, and roaming street performers entertain the nearly 17 million visitors who come to experience the vintage Vegas attraction each year.

Show in the Sky at the Masquerade Village – *Rio All Suite Hotel & Casino*

It's a unique performance every time, with three different shows featuring stunning dancers in eye-popping costume fashions from the likes of DKNY and Victoria's Secret. Your jaw will drop as these talented performers perform all-new routines to edgy music as fantasy floats glide above the crowd, creating an energetic and dynamic musical celebration.

Volcano Eruption – *Mirage* **Currently undergoing maintenance will be running Feb 15******

Since its opening in 1989, the volcano has been one of most popular attractions on the Strip. In 1996, the volcano added new water, lighting and sound effects. WET, the company responsible for The Fountains of Bellagio, led the design team for the volcano. The volcano includes two volcano systems, a lagoon and fire shooters that shoot flame on demand. These massive fireballs are capable of shooting more than 12 feet into the air. It also features waterfalls with surrounding pools including fire and smoke effects. One of the most exciting highlights of the volcano is its hypnotic music score. Hart, the legendary Grateful Dead drummer, and Indian music composer Zakir Hussain worked together to create and perform a soundtrack exclusively for the volcano.

“Welcome to Las Vegas” Sign – *Las Vegas Blvd*

Located on the Las Vegas Strip just south of Russell Road, the sign famously reads, "Welcome to Fabulous Las Vegas, Nevada" on the front and "Drive Carefully" and "Come Back Soon" on the back. The sign was designed by Betty Willis while she worked for Western Neon Company and cost \$4,000 to build and install. To access the parking lot at the "Welcome to Las Vegas" sign you must be going south on Las Vegas Boulevard heading away from Mandalay Bay and toward the Las Vegas Outlet Center.

The Auto Collections – The Quad Resort & Casino

The Auto Collections at Imperial Palace is entertaining for car aficionados and even those who wouldn't typically give cars the time of day. The Auto Collections showcases 300 classic cars including racing cars, muscle cars and much more. Since the exhibit is constantly changing, you'll never see the same set of cars twice. The 1963 Chevrolet Nova Memorial Racecar on display is dedicated to all the fallen and living United States Marines of the Iraq war. While this car isn't for sale, a picture is priceless. Another military vehicle on display is the flat grey 1941 Willy's military jeep. Used in the military during the beginning of World War II, the jeep was restored in 1959.

Eiffel Tower Observation Deck – Paris Hotel

Located in the heart of the Las Vegas Strip, visitors can catch great views nearly 50 stories above the ground. From the observation deck, which stands at 460 feet, guests are able to see the entire valley. And while the Eiffel Tower is a popular romantic destination, all types of guests come and see this attraction. The Eiffel Tower replica is about half the size of the original in France. While these two vary in height, there are many similarities between them. Both have an enclosed observation deck for safety as well as a glass elevator to admire the stunning vistas on the way to the top.

Gondola Rides – Venetian Hotel

Listening to an Italian serenade while floating in a gondola through the Venetian's Grand Canal Shoppes is a relaxing and entertaining experience. Following the popular Italian tradition, couples can kiss under each bridge for good luck. The indoor gondolas travel through the Grand Canal Shoppes and the ride lasts about 15 minutes. Admire the lovely Italian-inspired architecture inside the shops, as well as the blue sky-painted ceiling. The outdoor gondolas glide along a lagoon at the front of the hotel. While this ride is a couple of minutes shorter than the indoor one, it offers a breathtaking view of the Las Vegas Strip. The outdoor gondolas are subject to closing during inclement weather. Keep in mind that each gondola seats four, so you might be paired with another couple. Even if you're not here on a date, it's still a nice way to take a break and really get away from it all.

Madame Tussaud's Interactive Wax Museum – Venetian Hotel

Madame Tussauds has about 100 wax figures on the floor at any given time. The attraction adds about four or five new ones each year, partially based on suggestions from guests. Some of the most recent additions include actress Cameron Diaz, a twinkling-eyed Matthew McConaughey and Spiderman. "We like to pick people who we think have come to legendary status. The figures aren't retired very often, but they are removed from the floor periodically so their hair can be washed and makeup can be retouched.

At CSI: The Experience at MGM Grand, you'll go through a series of steps that will get you thinking like a real investigator. There are a total of three murders and 15 suspects, so you'll really get your mind going. Choose from one of three crime scenes, which appear like life-size dioramas. "A House Collided," displays a car through a living room window; "Who Got Served?" shows a young woman found dead behind a motel and "No Bones about It!" shows a human skull (along with other bones) buried in the desert. 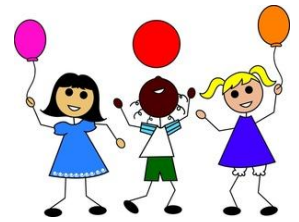

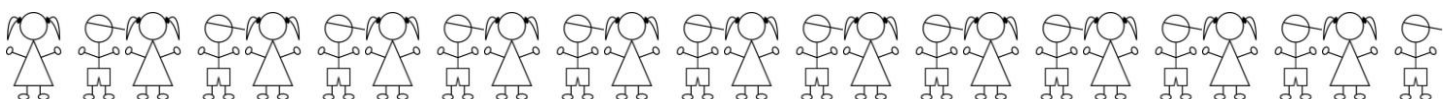

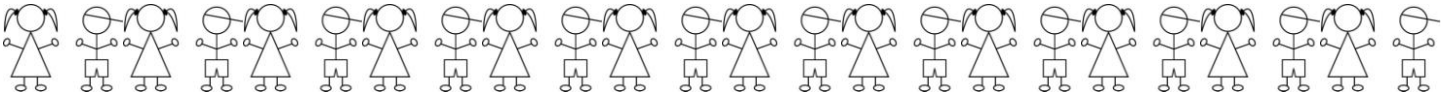

The 2.5-million-gallon Dolphin Habitat is home to a family of Atlantic bottlenose dolphins. Four connected pools, an artificial coral reef system and sandy bottom replicate the dolphins' natural environment.
